- Reading/homework diary




Our PE days will be Tuesday and swimming is on a Thursday afternoon, however your child is required to have their PE kit in school every day as per school policy.

Our Science topic this term will be Rock Detectives where we will be exploring the world around us and focusing on soil formation, types of rocks, fantastic fossils and gems!




Summer term 2019
