# Reading

- Guided Reading sessions in place each day in school, giving children an opportunity to read each day.
- Reading records will be checked weekly, children given opportunity to change books – please encourage children to change as and when needing to.
- Please ensure children read for 10 minutes every night. Encourage children to think of the detail they have read by questioning after.

# Writing

- Spelling's will be given out each Monday. We will do some practice each day in school before having the test each Friday.
- Presentation expectations
- Areas of learning this term include using a range of clauses, conjunctions, writing for different purposes.

# Maths

- Areas of learning this term include place value, addition and subtraction using 4-digit numbers, perimeter.
- 20 minute Maths each day, aiding fluency and mental maths.
- Multiplication Tables. Expectation by end of Year 4 to know all up to  $12x$ .
- Reasoning.

# RE

- Over the course of the year we will cover 9 topics plus other faiths.
- Each topic block spanning four weeks.
- Each topic will start with an 'Explore' homework. This will be clearly explained in class with supporting task sheet sent home. This will be used in RE books and therefore presentation expectations are high.
- RE lessons will include varying types of work including writing, drama, art and discussion.

# Homework

- Homework will be sent on a Friday.
- In order to be marked each week it has to be completed and handed in by Thursday at the latest each week.
- Homework will include Maths, English and RE.
- Homework will sometimes be set using Mathletics – log ins for this can be found in every child's Reading Diary.
- Weekly Spellings. Monday – Friday
- Daily Reading.
