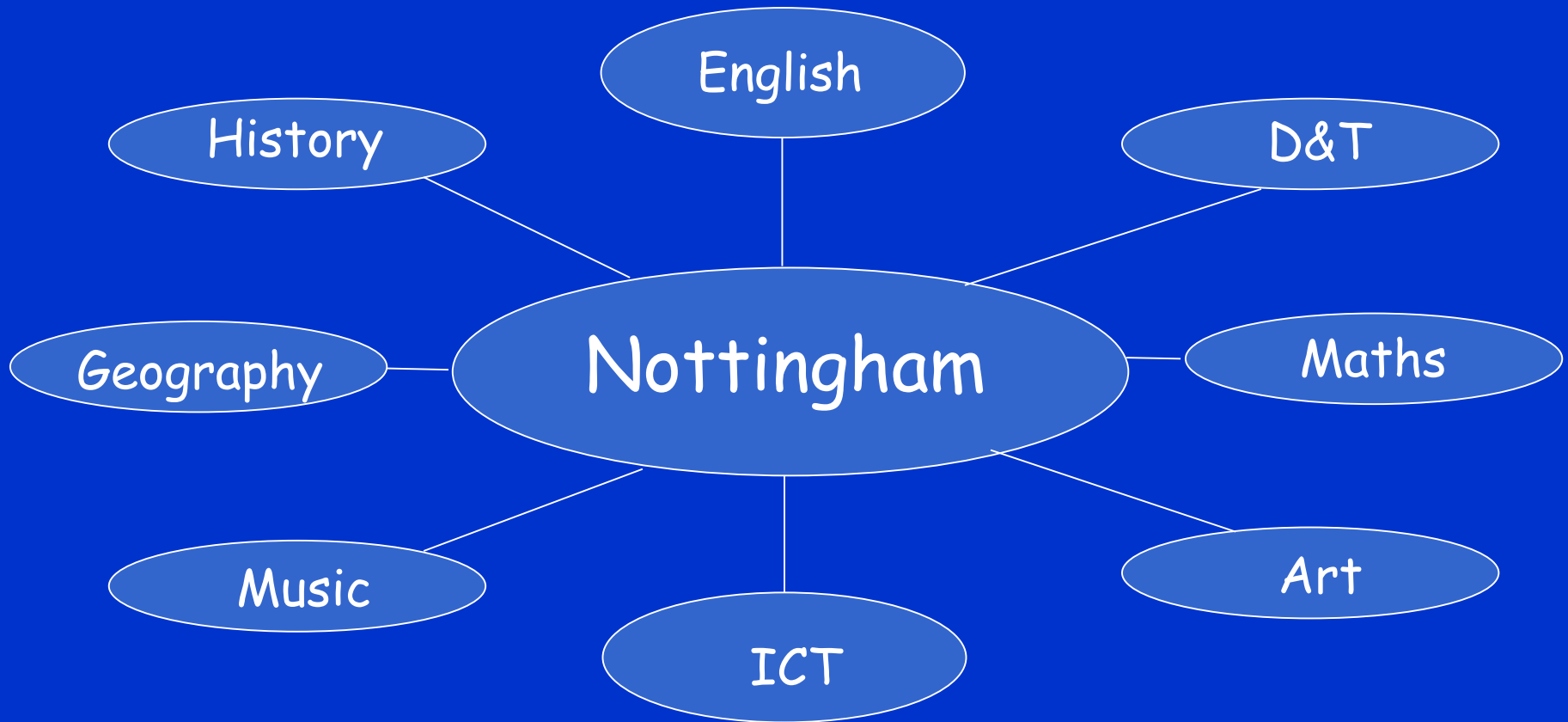

Reading

- Please sign reading records every weekend and every time your child has read (daily)
- Every week, we will check reading records for reading and parent/guardian signatures and sign them ourselves
- Please ensure that your child reads every night (10 minutes)
- Learning key words and asking questions about the books that they are reading

English

- Areas of learning this term - consolidation from Year 5; using a range of punctuation; writing for different purposes and audiences
- Spellings -new spellings to be given out on Mondays and the test is on a Friday
- Year 5/6 100 word list
- Expectations of presentation
- Guided Reading

Maths

- Areas of learning this term - place value, four operations, decimals, fractions
- Mental maths tests
- Real life problem solving/ reasoning
- Written and mental strategies
- Presentation of work
- To know by heart all the times tables up to x12 by the end of year 4 (daily practise)

Targets

- Your child will have a reading, writing and maths target each half term
- These aspects of English and Maths will be highlighted in the teaching for that half term

R.E.

- Four week block per topic
- Each topic will begin with an 'Explore' piece of work. We will explain the task carefully in school and then we expect everyone to complete it at home. This will go into their R.E. book so must be completed to a very high standard and returned to school on time.
- R.E. lessons involve drama, art, discussions and written work, as well as meditation and prayer.

Homework

- Homework will be given weekly on a Friday
- It must be handed in by 9.00 am the following Monday
- Weekly Spellings
- Times table practise
- Mathletics - login and password in reading diary
- Daily reading
