Topics for this term

Spring 1 We will be looking at a variety of traditional tales, such as “The Gingerbread Man”, “Goldilocks”, “The Little Red Hen”, “The Elves and the Shoemaker” and “The 3 Billy Goat’s Gruff”.

Spring 2 We will be learning about “Where I live”, finding out about houses and other buildings and some jobs people do. We will also be learning about new life and Spring and finding out about animal life-cycles. We hope to go on a local visit this half term.

R.E. Topics for this term

We will have 3 overall topics this term-**CELEBRATIONS, GATHERING** and **GROWING**. We will be finding out about how we celebrate Mass and having a treasure hunt in church.

Maths and Phonics

Both F1 and F2 children have specific number and phonics sessions. In F1, we are working on recognising and counting up to 5 and this extends in F2 to 20 and beyond. We also learn about recognising 2D and 3D shapes and pattern. In F2 we are continuing our reading challenge where children move up the chart each time they read at home. Please remember to record when they read in their diary.
