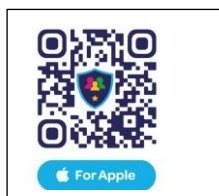
Safer Schools App for Parents and Pupil's Personal Devices

Our Safer School's App will help you educate, empower and protect your entire school community.

Alternatively download straight from the App Store or Google Play by searching 'Safer Schools'.

1. Select Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Multi-Academy Trust from the dropdown menu and click '**continue**'.
2. Enter the **four digit entry code** provided from the table below for your unique role.
3. Alternatively the user can scan the QR entry code for their role (table below) by clicking the '**Scan QR code**' button on the app login screen, which will automatically log the user in.
