A huge congratulations to our Year 5 and 6 football team who took part in a Gedling Schools Competition and won. They are now heading off to the county finals- we wish them luck!


Our Tag Rugby 5 and 6 team put in a very good show at a competition this week too – they won two, drew two and only lost one. Well done to all who competed.

First Holy Communion


If your child is baptised, in year 3 or above and wishes to make their first Holy Communion there are forms in the back of all three churches for parents to fill in and return.
