Friends of Sacred Heart - Your school needs your help!

We are looking to start a Friends of Sacred Heart Group that will consist of staff, parents and governors.

For this year, we have invested in a programme called OPAL schools. This is an outside playtime initiative that incorporate all 17 aspects of play to help the pupils learn how to play, cooperate, problem solve, risk take, use their imaginations and be engaged throughout lunchtimes. We sent two members of staff, Miss Armstrong and Miss Murray to a local OPAL flagship school and they came back so enthusiastic and excited that we plan to implement this at Sacred Heart that they volunteered to lead on the project. School have paid for staff to have training and for the outside areas to be improved, including much needed shade on the yard. However, due to the current funding levels of schools, we will need to raise funds to buy equipment and importantly storage of the equipment in order to implement this successfully.

We are hoping to hold a Christmas Fayre, a disco, cake sales, Easter raffles, sponsored events and a summer Fayre so our own children can not only experience these events and make memories but so we can implement our OPAL project successfully.

As a school community we are very excited about this project but do need your help. An hour a month support from the Friends of Sacred Heart would mean that events can be bigger and better than before.

Please consider joining our Friends of Sacred Heart group, come along to our first meeting in September for a brew and biscuit and find out more about our plans on September 13th at 2:30pm in school.
