


### **Behaviour Policy**

We are currently trialling a behaviour system that we hope to put fully in place for September. Feedback from pupils and staff has shown that the pupils and adults in school would like more visual representation of where they are on a behaviour scale and that they would like more tangible rewards. Previous feedback from parents which helped shape our existing policy, stated that further clarity and communication regarding your child's behaviour to you as parents was needed. We are constantly reviewing this and listening to staff, parents and pupils' views to improve the provision for pupils and will continue to do so.

### **Rewards**

We have put an increased onus on our House Points and every class have these displayed in their classrooms. Pupils can receive house points for doing something special, being seen to follow our Heart Values, not only in the classrooms but in the corridors, playground and around the school. The pupils are collecting for their own house group and for personal reward. The house with the most points will vote for a film to watch and enjoy one afternoon during the last week of term and the pupils with the most individual points will have a reward also.

#### The Heart

The Heart represents our Heart Values. This is where we expect pupils to be all of the time. They are showing that they are hardworking, aspirational, enthusiastic, respectful and show togetherness. If a pupil strays from our values, they will first be given a verbal reminder of how their behavior is not showing our values.

### White Thinking Cloud

If the pupil continues with this behaviour they will be moved to the white thinking cloud and given a warning.

### The Blue Thinking Cloud

If the behavior continues, they will be moved to the blue cloud. At this point they will spend 5 minutes of their break or dinnertime reflecting with their adult who has moved them.

The pupils voted that if a pupil calls another pupil a name they will automatically go to a blue cloud.

#### The Red Circle

If the behavior still continues the pupil will be moved to the red circle. At this point the pupil will miss all of their playtime or 30 minutes of their lunch play to reflect on their own behavior.

The pupils have voted that if a pupil uses inappropriate language, intentionally hurts another child or is disrespectful to staff it will be straight to red circle. Currently, a red circle means that SLT will become involved.

#### The Star

We know that we have pupils in our school who are exceptional. These pupils always go above and beyond not only in the life of the school but in their catholic life in the community. These pupils will be awarded the star with full staff agreement. They will receive a special reward at the end of every term and a recognition letter from Miss Hornsby

We all know that mistakes are made, we can all make the wrong choice on occasion. If you child does get put on any of the clouds or red circles, they can, through demonstrating the correct values, be moved back onto the heart.

Every child will start each day on the heart, we feel that this is important and in keeping with our Catholic Ethos.

We fully recognize that pupils with SEND needs will need adaptations to the system to ensure that we meet their own individual needs. Staff are working with pupils and our SENDCo to ensure their own system based on hearts can be adapted for their own needs.

A full consultation will be sent out at the end of next week to parents, pupils and staff so that feedback can be collected to form our policy for September.
